#### When is it?

#### What are the requirements?

To participate in **Duck the Malls** you must be selling **LOCAL** and **HANDMADE ORIGINAL** objects. Those wishing to sell cds, imports, food items, cosmetic products or services need not apply. No store bought or mass- produced items. We want to see what our brilliant local independent artists/ crafters are making, not whatever you could find at the big box stores.

#### How much does it cost?

The booth fee will be **\$35** dollars for Olympia Film Society **members** and **\$45** dollars for **non-members**, plus, **a bake sale treat on the day of the show**. Save money and become a member today!

#### How do I apply?

- A description of your work and how you make it.

- DEADLINES: The deadline for applications is November 1st so please get your e-mail in before then. We will let you know a couple days later if you have been accepted and then you have until November 8th to pay your booth fee.
